Proposed Operations Budget Highlights

Transportation

- Proposed changes to Sidewalk Snow Removal Budget incorporates plowing of 1km in St. Andrews West (new County Road 18 sidewalk) for 2021.
- Bridge/Culvert maintenance at Finch-Osnabruck Boundary Road Culvert and Shaver Road Bridges is included. Work not completed in 2020 due to COVID delays.
- Roads Needs Study/Road Condition Surveys to be completed
- OSIM Bridge Inspections to be completed
- Increase in Road Maintenance for 2021 includes:
 - Additional Tree Removal due to Emerald Ash Borer
 - Gravel Resurfacing schedule for 2021 includes 36.5km of gravel roads (31.1km 2020)
 - Storm sewer cleaning and video inspection

Waste Management

Heavy Garbage pickup <u>not</u> included in "Special Pickup" for 2021. (2020 Estimated cost \$39,000 plus disposal (\$60.48/T))

Project: Myers Road Reconstruction

4km East of County Road 15 (Avonmore Road)

- ADT 367 (2019) Condition Rating 4/10
- 10 Year Capital Plan 2021 (RNS 2017)
- Rationale Recommended in 2017 Road Needs Study for Partial Depth Asphalt Reconstruction
- Work Scope pulverize existing surface, incorporate into subgrade, additional granulars for shaping, replace road crossing culverts and entrance culverts as required. Estimate includes provisions for 1000m of ditching
- Cost \$660,000
- Funding Source Debenture

Project: Duffy's Road Reconstruction

1.2km west of County Rd.14 to Morgan Road

Proposed Capital Projects

- ► ADT 196 (2014) Condition Rating 3.5/10
- 10 Year Capital Plan 2018 (RNS 2017)
- Rationale Recommended in 2017 Road Needs Study for Pulverize and Double Surface Treatment
- Work Scope pulverize existing surface, incorporate into subgrade, additional granulars for shaping, replace road crossing culverts and entrance culverts as required. Estimate includes provisions for 1000m of ditching
- ▶ Cost \$198,450
- Funding Source Debenture

Proposed Capital Projects Transportation Services

Project: Savings Street Drainage Improvements

2.3km east of County Rd.12 to North Stormont Boundary

- ADT 152 (2014) Condition Rating 3/10
- Rationale Multiple requests from Councils for consideration for reconstruction. Current road has no ditches or provisions for drainage. Geotechnical investigation revealed silty sandy soil over topsoil in multiple locations. Intent is for drainage improvements in 2021 with road reconstruction proposed for 2022.
- Work Scope ditching and installation of entrance culverts throughout, replacement of cross culverts and installation of sub-drain where required
- Cost \$184,000
- Funding Source Debenture









Replacement of 1km of sidewalk on County Road 18, east of Hwy.138

Proposed Capital Projects

- Rationale Current 1.2m (4ft) concrete sidewalk is at the end of its useful life.
- Work Scope Sidewalk to be replaced with 1.5m (5ft) asphalt sidewalk as part of SDG Counties Road Rehabilitation project in St. Andrews
- Cost \$143,700
- Funding Source Carry forward project for 2020





Proposed BUDGET 2021

Project: Valade Road Bridge Rehabilitation

Rationale - 2019 OSIM Bridge Inspection recommended rehab in 2022

Proposed Capital Projects

- Work Scope construction of new ballast walls, topping slab replacement, new curbs and barriers to protect exterior girders, new concrete end walls guide rail and end treatments
- Cost \$450,000
- Funding Source Gas tax Fund





Proposed BUDGET 2021

Project: Red Bridge (Lefebvre Road) Engineering

Rationale - Red Bridge identified in 2019 OSIM Bridge inspections as requiring rehabilitation to rectify issues with joints and barriers and rectify drainage issues damaging exterior girders.

Proposed Capital Projects

- Work Scope Final design and preparation of Tender Documents for 2022 Construction.
- Cost \$13,000
- Funding Source Carry forward from 2020

Proposed Capital Projects Transportation Services

Project: Lakeside Drive - East Island Road Engineering

- Rationale Completion of design, addressing road misalignment, drainage issues and gravel to asphalt surface upgrade.
- Work Scope Topographic and geotechnical survey, final design and preparation of tender documents for 2022 Construction.
- Cost \$51,000
- Funding Source 2021 Tax Dollars





Proposed BUDGET 2021

Project: Capital Sidewalks

Rationale - Sidewalk replacement in various locations to improve level of service and meet OADA requirements.

Proposed Capital Projects

- Work Scope Replacement of sidewalks in higher traffic areas which have reached the end of their useful life.
- Cost \$75,000
- Funding Source Gas Tax Fund





Proposed BUDGET 2021

Project: St. Andrews School Pedestrian Crossover

Rationale - School's traffic consultant has recommended installation of pedestrian crossover to mitigate pedestrian/traffic conflict at school parking area.

Proposed Capital Projects

- Work Scope Installation of crossover lighting and associated line painting in coordination with SDG Counties.
- Cost \$25,000
- Funding Source Carry over from 2020





Proposed BUDGET 2021

Project: New Streetlights

- Rationale Additional streetlights as per staff recommendation and resident requests.
- Work Scope Installation of 3-5 new streetlights. Proposed expenditure does not cover residents' requests or staff recommendations.

Proposed Capital Projects

- Cost \$15,000
- Funding Source 2021 Tax Dollars





Proposed BUDGET 2021

Project: 1 Ton truck with Dump Box

- Rationale Replacement of 2011 Half Ton truck as per vehicle replacement schedule.
- Work Scope 2011 Half Ton truck has reached the end of its service life. Upgrade to 1 Ton truck with dump box better suits current uses.

Proposed Capital Projects

Vehicle Replacement

- Cost \$65,000
- Funding Source 2021 Tax Dollars





Proposed BUDGET 2021

Project: Flat Bed Tandem Trailer

Rationale - Replacement of tandem trailer as per vehicle replacement schedule.

Proposed Capital Projects

Vehicle Replacement

- Work Scope Upgrade required as trailer has reached the end of its service life.
- Cost \$10,000

Funding Source - 2021 Tax Dollars

Project: Trillium Landfill - Final Cover

- Rationale Final cover of approximately 30% of Landfill. As landfill approaches the end of its useful life final cover is required to meet legislated requirements. Cover will also mitigate penetration of surface water, reducing plume migration.
- Work Scope Purchase and placement of clay cover, topsoil and overseeding
- Cost \$75,000
- Funding Source 2021 Tax Dollars

Proposed BUDGET 2021 Project: Trillium Landfill Water Rights Easement Acquisition

- Rationale Trillium Landfill has not met the requirements of MOECP Guideline B7 "Reasonable Use of Groundwater Policy" requiring the acquisition of Ground water rights.
- Work Scope Purchase of water rights easement, legal survey, consulting fees and Environmental Compliance Approval amendment. Negotiated purchase of water rights easement is within proposed budget.

Cost \$453,000

Funding Source - Debenture

Project: Purchase of 2 Garbage Trucks

Rationale - Tender for two garbage trucks in 2020as per Township's vehicle replacement schedule (2019)

Proposed Capital Projects

Waste Management

- Work Scope First truck scheduled for 2020 delayed by COVID, second scheduled for early 2021 also delayed. (First truck scheduled for delivery week of March 8.)
 - Cost \$350,000
 - Funding Source \$122,400 from 2021 tax dollars, \$226,600 carryover from 2020







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
